WHICH BPH TREATMENT IS RIGHT FOR MY PATIENT?

Determining if medical therapy or surgery is most appropriate is the first step here.

INVESTIGATIONS

- Urine analysis or MSU blood or infection
- UEC
- Renal Ultrasound
 – gives information on prostate size, sometimes shape and importantly chronic bladder damage (trabeculation and diverticulae), incomplete emptying and also kidney damage

PSA

MEDICAL VS. SURGICAL

Medical therapy generally should be initiated before considering surgical therapy.

Surgical intervention is necessary in patients with urinary retention or infections

Choosing the right procedure for your patient:

HoLEP: size independant, histology obtained


UroLift: 80g or <, Not suitable in patients with obstructing median lobe

Rezum: 30-80g, ideally no medium lobe, minimal obstructive symptoms

There are several short and long-term advantages that HoLEP has over older style procedures. These include:

- Far less bleeding
- No erectile dysfunction
- Lowest re-operation rate of all bladder outlet surgeries
- · Catheter time and hospital stay halved
- · Greater max flow rate
- Greater symptom improvement
- Protects the bladder and kidneys from chronic damage therefore avoid longterm catheters, infections and retention of urine
- · Histological analysis of all tissue
